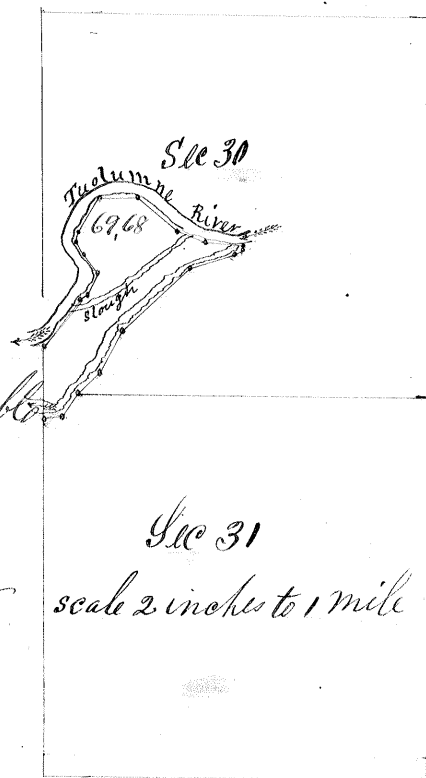

Beginning at Meander post on the West Line of Sec 31
thence follow on following the U.S. Meander Line Run
→ N 82° E 3.73 ch, N 32° E 5.85 ch, to Meander Post on Line between Secs 30 & 31
thence N 45° E 6.00 ch, N 28° E 10.00 ch, N 45 3/4° E 19.00 ch, N 73° E 10.00 ch, N 62 1/4° E 1.70 ch,
to 1/4 Sec Line thence N 72° W 4.00 ch, to the Left Bank of the Tuolumne
River. Meander down Stream Run N 85 1/4° W 7.96 ch, N 73° W 5.75 ch,
N 50 1/4° W 11.00 ch, S 88° W 8.00 ch, S 31 1/4° W 8.72 ch, S 10 1/2° W 2.28 ch, S 32° E 2.82 ch, ^{used}
S 52 1/4° E 4.95 ch, S 31 1/4° W 5.32 ch, S 60 1/4° W 1.92 ch, S 87 1/4° W 1.16 ch, to West Line
of Sec 30 thence S 36° E 15.64 ch, to place of beginning
