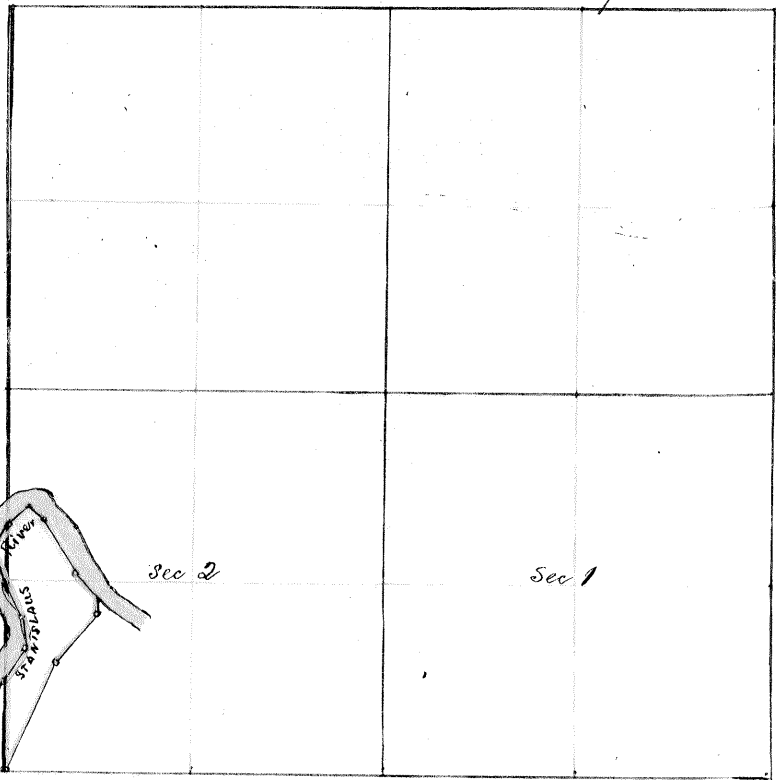


Swamp and Overflowed Lands

### Field Notes.

Beginning at the intersection of the N & S line between the E  $\frac{1}{2}$  and W  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the W  $\frac{1}{2}$  of sec 2, Township 3 south, range 7 east, with the left bank of the Stanislaus river, thence south 3.50 chains to a post and mound set at intersection with U. S. meander line, thence along said meander line down stream N 55  $\frac{1}{2}$  W 0.27 lks, S 39  $\frac{3}{4}$  W 13 ch, S 30 W 24 ch, to post and mound at the corner of sections 2, 3, 10 & 11, thence N 17.56 chains to a post set at intersection with the left bank of the Stanislaus river, thence meander up stream N 22 E 7.50 ch, N 69 W 8 ch, N 19 W 9.50 ch, N 23 E 6.50 ch, N 50 E 6 ch, S 60  $\frac{3}{4}$  E 5 ch, S 24 E 13 ch, S 62  $\frac{1}{4}$  E 6 chains to point of beginning.

Run by the true Meridian, Magnetic Variation 15° 45' East.

Surveyed in accordance with the Act of the Legislature concerning Swamp and Overflowed Lands, approved April 18<sup>th</sup> 1859, and the instruction of the Surveyor-General.
